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Aims and Ethos of Delhi Public School, Durgapur Hostel

Within hostel at Delhi Public School, Durgapur we aim to provide a family atmosphere in which each child feels safe, happy and valued whilst staying away from home. The health, safety and well-being of all our children are of paramount importance to all those who work in the school. All children have the right to protection, regardless of age, gender, race, culture or disability, ensuring a secure and stable environment exists. They have a right to be safe in school and the school follows a specific child protection policy. We are committed to creating and maintaining an environment that discourages bullying and deal constructively with any instances that may occur following the whole school anti-bullying policy. We aim to promote an open and trusting ethos ensuring each child's right to privacy, dignity, independence and individuality. Each child must be treated fairly, and we aim to encourage children to learn to exercise a degree of freedom in a responsible way, which develops behaviour traits of respect, courtesy, honesty, care, co-operation and building positive relationships between each other. We follow the whole school behaviour for learning policy, which is designed to support the way in which all members of the school live and work together. Children's emails, letters, phone calls, both incoming and outgoing, are completely without censor, and the personal cupboard space is private and must not be opened in the child'sabsence, and with the agreement of the child and the House wardens. As part of the holistic development of every boarder at Delhi Public School, Durgapur we pride ourselves on the emotional and mental wellbeing of children within our care. Children need to express their fears and emotions.

The Hostel team is always there to listen to children after a busy day, helping to promote a strong and healthy mental wellbeing so they will be able to:

- Feel confident about themselves and have positive self-esteem
- Feel and express a range of emotions
 - Build and maintain good relationships with others
- Feel engaged with the world around them
- Cope with the stresses of daily life
- Adapt and manage in times of change and uncertainty.

We hope to create a familial atmosphere so that each child feels the hostel to be an extension of home. We strongly believe that the children should be the center of the Hostel running process.



Admission Rules

- Only Birth Certificate issued by Municipal Corporation or as shown in the Passport, should be uploaded. Please do not upload Birth Certificates issued by Nursing Home/Hospital.
- Please upload latest passport sized coloured photographs of the student, parents or guardian (if applicable) on the designated place of the Application Form.
- Take print out of the submitted Application Form and Admit Card in a clean white A4 sheet paper.
- Please paste passport sized coloured photographs (must be identical to the uploaded photographs) of the student, parents or guardian on the designated place of the printed Application Form.
- Date of assessment /observation/ interaction/interview will be mentioned in the Admit Card and mailed to you shortly after submission of the Application Form.

- During assessment / observation / interaction / Interview Admit Card (print out taken by parents) must be produced.
- There will be an assessment on the intimated date for students seeking admission to Class I onwards. During the assessment, presence of both the parents will be mandatory.
- For admission to Nursery & LKG, the teacher only observes/interacts with the child along with the parents. Both the parents must accompany the child.
- For admission to UKG, there will be an observation and interaction for assessment. Both the parents must accompany the child.
- No request for any change of dates for assessment/observation/interaction/
 Interview will be entertained.

Admission Policy: The child has to first follow the admission process of the school and then can opt for Hostel Facility.

Supporting Documents other than school admission Procedure: Parent's Request Letter to enroll in hostel, documents of local guardian with parents' authorization letter.

E-MAIL: Parents can send request for leave by sending an email to hostel.leaveapplication@dpsdurgapur.net If there is any issue that needs further discussion, such an issue will be taken care by the academic coordinators.





Meals in a day

A well-balanced nutritious diet (4 times a day) is served in clean and hygienic dining hall. Filtered cold and warm water (during winters) is available. Special meals are provided on special occasions.

Parents are to notify the warden if their child is allergic to any food being served at the hostel. This will help the wardens to make alternate arrangements and keep a check on the child's food to avoid any allergic reactions or sickness.



Medical Facility

In case a child is down with contagious infection, parents are requested to keep them at home to avoid spreading the infection to the other students. Parents need to inform the school office regarding the absence, followed by a letter and necessary medical documents when the child re-joins school.

Delhi Public School has a fully equipped Infirmary which is looked after by a qualified nurse. Medical check-ups of students are regularly carried out and a record is maintained. If the doctor is of the opinion that a child needs special medical attention, the parents are informed of the same.



Birthday Celebration

Birthday Celebration will be allowed only on Parent's request within a limited budget and arrangements by parents. Students are allowed to talk on a video call with the family.

Sports Facilities

Hostel Facilities

In-Campus Separate Hostels for Boys and Girls: Located in-campus, the school offers separate hostel facilities for boys and girls, and it is open for students from Classes V to XII.

Accommodation: Well-furnished dormitories with separate bed, study table and wardrobe for each student. Each floor has a toilet block with multiple toilets and bathrooms. AC hostel coming soon.

Tuition and Remedial Classes: The hostellers are provided with tuition classes on a regular basis by highly experienced teachers. Remedial sessions in various subjects are organised as per requirement. Special preparations are arranged for NEET/IIT/JEE students.

Entertainment & Outings: Popular movies and important sport events are shown on the big screen in the Audio-Visual Hall. Once in a month outing to the city and nearby areas by school buses happen under the supervision of the Wardens.

Sick Bay: The infirmary is run under the guidance of qualified nurse. The school has tie-up with few prominent hospitals of the city for emergency treatment.

Quest for Excellence: The air-conditioned library (Resource Centre) has an impressive collection of books, reference books and encyclopedia. It also offers a large pool of audio and video resources. Books specific to competitive exams are there to help students crack National and State level competitive exams.

Art, Dance & Music: Special classes are held regularly for boarders to pursue their passion for art, music and dance under the supervision of expert teachers.


Recreational Block: Soon a multi-storied recreational block will be operational, with covered all-weather swimming pool, badminton courts and other facilities.

Games, Common Room and Internet: Well-equipped Gymnasium, facilities for Football, Cricket, Basketball, Badminton, Table Tennis, Carrom, Pool and Chess are available to the students. The common rooms have TV and PCs with Internet connection.



Student Behavior

STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO:



General Rules



- Room furniture, electric fittings, etc. are required to be maintained by the inmates in good condition. At the time of allotment of room and leaving the hostel for the vacation, every student must take-over and hand-over, the hostel property carefully.
- 3 Students must NOT keep with themselves laptop, mobile, iPod, pen drives / hard disks, i-pods, razors, blades, heaters, kettles, irons, immersion rod etc.
- 4 Students must NOT bring to the Boarding, drugs of any type, tobacco in any form or alcohol. Any student found with such items will be asked to be withdrawn from the school immediately.
- Boarders must remain, and study in their respective rooms/dorms or classrooms during study time as directed by the authority.
- Boarders must take part in all the educational activities arranged by the school or hostel.
- Any wilful damage to or theft of school property or other's property will be regarded as a breach of School/ Hostel rules and the student would be fined by School Authorities.
- The Campus Administrator / Hostel Wardens / or any other Officials of the School along with Security Guards may at their discretion inspect /check any room or student's belongings in the presence of the students living there, in any time of the day or night.
- Ragging and bullying of any kind is severely punishable and may lead to expulsion from the school. As such, students are advised not to indulge in any such activity. No one is permitted to subject any other student to any kind of ill-treatment, either physical or mental.

- Any child involved in any immoral act is liable to be expelled without warning, and there will be no reconsideration whatsoever. There will be no refund of fee in such cases. Furthermore, Principal or the disciplinary committee may not assign any reason for doing so.
- Students are not permitted to possess any sordid reading/ viewing material.
- No student is permitted to buy, sell or exchange goods or lend or borrow money from each other or from the staff.

 Nor are they allowed to do so with any outsider especially when they go for outings from the school.
- The change of status from boarder to day scholar will not be entertained in the mid-session.
- All students must report on the given date after the vacation/leave etc., In case of any emergency, written request giving detailed reasons, should be provided by the parents to the Principal, and a written permission must be obtained to condone the delay in arrival.
- Laundry is given on the days notified by the competent authority. It will be washed, pressed and returned to the Boarders as approved by the hostel council. In case of loss or damage, the Boarders must inform the laundry personnel immediately. The complaint could also be entered in the complaint book provided in the hostel.
- Rules may be changed without prior information to the parents and students. Parents/guardians seeking admission for their ward should carefully read the rules and regulations of the school, as well as hostel. Lack of knowledge of rules and regulations can't be accepted as an excuse.

Gentle Grooming

- 1 'Early to bed and early to rise' is very much practiced in the hostel. All the students will be in and out of their beds as per the hostel schedule.
- 2 Morning activities are compulsory except if excused on medical ground.
- **3** A high level of personal hygiene must be always maintained.
- 4 'Cleanliness is next to Godliness'. Keeping this in mind the students will maintain their cupboard and cubicle in a neat and tidy manner.
- 5 Students must follow the dress code strictly as per the occasion/ timings. Funky hairdos (spikes/streaks) are not allowed.
- 6 Girls/Boys will always dress decently.
- 7 Girls/Boys are not allowed to wear sleeveless shirts or shorts in the refectory.
- 8 Shorts can be worn by the students only during games and in their respective rooms.
- 9 The student will inform the Hostel Warden if any maintenance work is required in their room.
- 10 The hostel building is out of bound during school hours.
- 11 The students will sleep in night wear only.
- 12 Before sleeping students should be prepared for the next day in terms of uniform, polishing shoes and completing home assignment.
- 13 Bullying or ragging in any form (verbal, physical and emotional) is not accepted.
- 14 If any student damages the school property, the cost will be recovered from the imprest account.
- 15 School personnel can check student's belongings, if required, at any time.
- 16 TV and computer usage is limited and will be allowed only as per the schedule.

Rules for Hostellers

- 1. Boarders must remain, and study in their respective rooms/dorms or classrooms during study time as directed by the competent authority.
- 2. The lights-off time will be notified later on, and the students are expected to abide by the rule.
- 3. Boarders are expected to behave well in public and represent their school with pride.
- 4. During study hours, all students must devote their time to academic preparation in the study room. Silence is mandatory.
- Students must work independently, unless they are allowed for a group study session with full knowledge of hostel wardens. Group study sessions will happen in common areas and not in individual rooms.
- 6. Students are expected to utilize the time fruitfully by spending the allotted time in studying.

 They must not waste this time in room corridors / common rooms / washrooms / mess.
- 7. Taps in bathroom/toilets must be closed, whenever they are not in use. Fans, A.C. and lights must be switched off whenever the students leave their rooms. They must switch off all lights, when they go to bed. In case it is noticed that the fans / lights / A.C.s are switched on in the bolted room, aenalty will be imposed for wasting precious energy.
- 8. Cleanliness and Hygiene: All students are expected to maintain a high standard of personal hygiene. Daily bath and personal cleanliness are essential. Students are to tidy up their own rooms, beds and cupboards. The rooms/cupboards will be checked by Hostel Committee on a surprise visit.
- 9. The student shall take prior permission of the Warden / Campus Administrator for celebrating any festivals and birthdays. Birthday celebration should be done at a common area and there should not be any kind of discomfort to other students. No outside guest or interference of any kind will be allowed.
- 10. Any boarder falling sick, will report to the hostel wardens, who will record the action taken, in the sick register. It should be signed both by the student and house master.
- 11. Physical exercise, meditation, sports, games, yoga and other relaxation activities are compulsory for all boarders, unless exempted by the competent authority. Separate schedule may be fixed for boys and girls, depending upon their class.
- 12. They are not allowed to wear any kind of studs or rings on the eyebrows, chin, ears, nose etc.
- 13. Students are not allowed to wear low waist trousers or skirts or narrow bottom trousers. No bracelets, fancy pendants or amulets are to be worn by the students.

Mess Rules for Hostellers

- Mess menu will be designed by the hostel management committee normally on term basis, in consultation with mess manager and approval of the Principal. The menu shall be displayed in the dining hall of the hostel.
- The students should strictly observe the prescribed mess timings. Late or early breakfast will be served only in exceptional cases, with prior consent of the mess manager.
- On request from sick students, separate food will be prepared in mess and will be served in his/her room, if so required.
- Wastage of food in the mess must be avoided.
- Mess utensils are not to be taken out of the dining hall.
- Mess is operated with limited staff and during peak hours, it is observed that it becomes difficult to cater to the demands of all the students dining at a time. The students should, therefore, wait patiently for their turn to be served. Mess manager will take care to serve the students effectively during peak hours.



Fees Deposit and Advances

1. Fees must be deposited within the stipulated period.

2. Payment of fee and other dues should be made only to the school office.

3. Except for the routine payments and charges notified by the Principal, no additional payment should be made without a notice as required. For any deposit contrary to this, school will not be responsible.

No cash is given to the students for the purchase of stationery or other items from school canteen or tuck shop or from anywhere outside. Cash can be given to the Warden; students can collect it from Warden as per requirement. Written record has to be maintained.







- Parents/guardians are not permitted to meet the boarders, without the permission of the Hostel Wardens. They will be allowed to meet the students only on prescribed days (Sunday). During school hours, parents/guardians are not allowed to visit their wards.
- Due to security reasons, only parents/ guardians whose photographs are kept in the authorized register at the hostel are permitted to visit the students and take them on long weekends. Therefore parents are requested to hand over their photographs, their details and the authorised guardians phone numbers and photograph to the school office.
- 3 If during the course of a session a student needs to go home, he/she must obtain permission from the Coordinator & a class teacher in the form of a Leave Request and provide a written request sent by the concerned parents to the administrator, giving the valid reason and documents. In this regard, the school's leave policy will be observed.
- No permissions will be granted to any student living in hostel for spending night out on weekends unless the parent themselves are available in the town and the student is staying with them.
- 5 Parents are advised not to contact the students during mandatory study hours.
- 6 Any application for attending marriages, functions or any other events during the school term will not be entertained, unless it pertains to the parents or siblings. Written permission in this regard must be obtained in time. No messages over the telephone and WhatsApp will be accepted in this regard.
- Parents should not supply medicines to the students, unless, specially advised by the family doctor. These must be handed over to the hostel wardens along with instruction/ prescription regarding its administration. Such medicines are to be administered entirely at the cost and responsibility of the parents.
- 8 Children will not be allowed to go with the drivers unless authorisation letter with photograph is sent by the parents.
- On school holidays (Summer Vacation, Winter Vacation, Durga puja etc) students are not allowed to remain in the hostel. Parents have to get the tickets done keeping the test/ exams timings of the school in mind. No students will be allowed to leave early or extend the block holidays.
- Parents desiring to send any item to their ward should either deliver the same to the Warden or his/her nominee personally. Nothing should be delivered to the boarder directly.
- Parents are requested not to confirm leave from students over phone. Parents should confirm over phone with warden then only plan to come to take the child.
- 2 Students are allowed to talk to the parents from Landline on fix days only on registered numbers. No students are allowed to carry the mobile phone. Video Calls are only allowed on the Child's Birthday/Parent's birthday/Sibling Birthday.

A regular conventional reading and learning is monotonous at times. DPS Durgapur provides the students with an open-ended learning that acknowledges the need of multiple fun and interesting activities incorporated into the visions of broader system of education. The clubs and the wide range of activities, keep the students engaged in various creative tasks that help them to rediscover their innate abilities in different ways. The clubs of the school are:

Book Club


